Salivary glands:

1. Warthin Tumor
2. pleomorphic adenoma

1. pheochromocytoma

Heart:

1. myocarditis
2. pericarditis
3. myocardial infarction

Vessels:

1. atherosclerotic plaque
2. capillary hemangioma
3. lymphangioma

OUN:

1. glioblastoma
2. ependymoma
3. lung adenocarcinoma metastases
4. acute bacterial meningitis

Liver and bile ducts:

1. nutmeg liver
2. centrilobular necrosis
3. steatosis
4. cirrhosis
5. cavernous hemangioma
6. hepatocellular carcinoma
7. cholangiocarcinoma
8. metastatic adenocarcinoma

Stomach:

1. Helicobacter gastritis
2. adenocarcinoma, diffuse type - signet ring cell carcinoma

Large intestine:

1. pseudomembranous colitis
2. villous adenoma
3. tubular adenoma
4. hyperplastic polyp
5. adenocarcinoma

Appendix:

1. gangrenous appendicitis
2. phlegmonous appendicitis
3. oxyuriasis
4. carcinoid - well differentiated neuroendocrine tumor/neoplasm (NET)

Esophagus:

1. Barrett's esophagus without dysplasia

Prostate:

1. adenocarcinoma, Gleason score 3+3

Testis:

1. seminoma
2. yolk sac tumor

Ovary:

1. mucinous cystadenoma
2. serous cystadenocarcinoma

Cervix:

1. high-grade squamous intraepithelial lesion - CIN III, carcinoma in situ

Kidney:

1. renal amyloidosis
2. nodular glomerulosclerosis, Kimmelstiel-Wilson disease
3. clear cell renal cell carcinoma
4. papillary renal cell carcinoma

Skin:

1. squamous cell carcinoma
2. basal cell carcinoma
3. compound nevus
4. superficial spreading melanoma - SSM
5. multinucleated foreign body giant cell granulomatous reaction
